The Project:

The Centre for Healthcare Quality and Innovation based at the Faculty of Health Sciences is seeking to hire one locum Qualitative Research Specialist for a three-month period for various studies based CHQI.

Job Purpose:

To lead the design, execution, and oversight of all qualitative research activities within the evaluation work streams.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Design qualitative research SOP outlining the evaluation methodology, sampling strategy, data collection methods, and analysis plan.
- 2. Support the drafting and finalize qualitative data collection tools, including semi-structured Online Survey Tools, Key Informant Interview (KII) guides and Focus Group Discussion (FGD) quides.
- 3. Design and conduct a training for the field data collection team.
- 4. Implement a systematic qualitative analysis, using appropriate techniques.
- 5. Support Preparation comprehensive Final Qualitative Evaluation Reports.

Job Specification:

- 1. PhD or Master's degree in Public Health **OR** Health Humanities (Medical Anthropology, Medical Sociology); with an undergraduate degree in Humanities;
- 2. At least 10 years' experience in qualitative research in health contexts;
- 3. Knowledge of LMICs health systems.

These are temporary, full time positions for an initial period of three (3) months with possibility of extension.
