##### **The Project:**

The Centre for Healthcare Quality and Innovation based at the Faculty of Health Sciences is seeking to hire 16 temporary Research Associates for a three-month period for various studies based in Nairobi, Central and Eastern Kenya.

##### **Job Purpose:**

To recruit study participants and collect qualitative and quantitative data.

1. Operationalize study SOPs on site activation, data extraction, participant recruitment, and data collection
2. Ensure compliance to study protocol and institutional guidelines
